## **HACM PUBLIC SAFETY DEPARTMENT MARKS TWO YEARS OF STRONG PROGRESS UNDER CHIEF DAVIS**



Under Public Safety Chief Marlon E. Davis’ leadership over the past two years, HACM’s Public Safety Department has strengthened safety initiatives across HACM housing communities. The department has advanced data-driven strategies, deepened partnerships with local law enforcement, and expanded resident-focused outreach to foster safer, more connected communities. These efforts have contributed to a noticeable decline in calls for service.

The department has also emerged as a true launch pad for emerging law enforcement professionals, attracting team members who are motivated, service-driven, and committed to the department’s high standards of conduct, ethics, and performance. This culture of accountability and growth continues to elevate the team’s overall effectiveness.

Commissioner James Nelson, Sr., a five-year Arlington Court resident, offered strong praise for the department’s impact: “I’ve seen the good, the bad, and the ugly at Arlington Court. Week after week, you showed up to our Resident Organization meetings and stayed engaged. That’s real teamwork. I appreciate how you’ve helped keep our community safe, even in challenging times.”

Supported by an engaged Board, the department is steadily reshaping past perceptions and advancing confidently toward its goal of maintaining safe, secure, and thriving environments for all residents, staff, and visitors.

## FLASHBACK FRIDAY: SECTION 8(Y) PROGRAM OPENS DOORS TO HOMEOWNERSHIP



In 2000, Congress and HUD created the Section 8(y) Homeownership Program, allowing Housing Choice Voucher holders to use their rental vouchers toward mortgage payments. Since its launch, 289 low-income families have purchased a home through the program, gaining stability and building equity in their communities.
